

Activities and Achievements of Panchayati Raj Department for November 2016 during the year 2016-17

The Panchayati Raj Department has been entrusted with implementation of various Poverty Alleviation Programmes in the State. The Poverty Alleviation Programmes mainly cater to the needs of rural families living below the poverty line. These Programmes can be grouped under the following four broad categories:-

1. Self Employment Programme

National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) :-

During the current financial year 2016-17, up to November 2016, an amount of ₹7141.19 lakhs has been utilized against the total available funds of ₹13778.34 lakhs. The Percentage of utilization is 52%. 38251 numbers of SHGs have been Credit linked out of 75000 numbers of SHGs.

As compared to this, an amount of ₹7010.00 lakhs was utilized out of total available funds of ₹10619.00 lakhs. The utilization of fund is 66% and 30210 numbers of SHGs have been promoted out of 60346 SHGs.

In scheduled areas, up to November 2016 in the current financial year 2016-17, an amount of ₹2118.37 lakhs has been utilized out of total allocation of ₹3451.08 lakh. The utilization of fund is 61%. 8887 numbers of SHGs have been Credit linked out of 16000 numbers of SHGs.

2. Wage Employment Programme

Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS):-

During the current financial year 2016-17 up to November 2016 an amount of ₹163891.89 lakh has been utilized against the total available funds of ₹165351.52 lakh. The utilization of fund is 99%. 523.20 lakh person days have been generated against the target of 800.00 lakh.

As compared to this, an amount of ₹109743.00 lakh was utilized in the corresponding period of the previous year 2015-16 out of available funds of ₹111218.00 lakh. The utilization of fund was 99%. 379.15 lakh person days were generated against the total target of 760.06 lakh.

In scheduled areas, up to November 2016 in the current financial year 2016-17, an amount of ₹83147.30 lakh has been utilized against the total available funds of ₹80847.42 lakh. The utilization of fund was 103%. And 246.61 lakhs person days have been generated against the total target of 341.15 lakhs.

3. Infrastructure Development

(i) Gopabandhu Gramin Yojana (GGY) :-

It provides additional developmental assistance in all the districts of the State. The principal objective is to provide rural infrastructure primarily Bijli, Sadak & Pani to every revenue village in the districts.

It is a State plan scheme launched in 2006-07 and the entire fund is provided by the State Government.

Expenditure to the tune of ₹43798.99 lakhs has been incurred up to November 2016 in the current financial year 2016-17 against the available funds of ₹151874.24 lakhs which constitutes 29%. 18218 number of works have been completed out of 34547 number of works taken up.

As compared to this ₹5166.00 lakhs was utilized out of total available funds of ₹28464.00 lakhs in the corresponding period of the previous year 2015-16 which constituted 18%. 2951 no. of works were completed out of 3257 number of works taken up.

In scheduled areas, up to November 2016 in the current financial year 2016-17, an amount of ₹ 14341.35 has been utilized against the total available funds of ₹53078.60 lakhs. The utilization of fund is 27%. 5637 no. of works have been completed against the target of 16300.
